Associate or technical degree (or higher) in a related field preferred. Maintains and calibrates all controls on boilers, generators, alarm systems, electrical panels, various meters, pressure transmitters and gauges throughout the plant. Maintains and make appropriate changes to plant SCADA system. Maintains repairs and installs adjustable frequency drives. Troubleshoots and repairs electrical wiring, circuits, breakers, and other electrical equipment; repair actuators, valves, regulators, and controllers. Participates in the construction, repair, replacement, maintenance, and operations of generating units and associated auxiliary equipment and systems Considerable knowledge of methods, practices, techniques, and equipment related to the calibration of instruments, controls, gauges, valve positioners, transmitters and control loops; and safety standards and precautions pertaining to the use and operation of hand and power tools and equipment.
