This position will perform responsible technical work testing, maintaining, repairing, installing, and calibrating instruments, controls, gauges, electrical and monitoring equipment used in a City plant and satellite stations. Maintain and calibrate all controls on boilers, generators, alarm systems, electrical panels, various meters, pressure transmitters and gauges throughout the plant. Maintain and make appropriate changes to plant SCADA system. Maintain, repair and install adjustable frequency drives. Troubleshoot and repair electrical wiring, circuits, breakers, and other electrical equipment. An associate or technical degree (or higher) in a related field is preferred. A minimum of three years relevant experience with a degree; or a minimum of five years relevant experience without a degree. Considerable knowledge of methods, practices, techniques, and equipment related to the calibration of instruments, controls, gauges, valve positioners, transmitters and control loops; and safety standards and precautions pertaining to the use and operation of hand and power tools and equipment.
