



MWWC Section's Operators of the Year

The purpose of the section's operator of the year awards is to recognize operators on the regional level who have shown outstanding performance and dedication in their field. Recipients of the section's operator of the year awards must be current members of the Missouri Water and Wastewater Conference.

Guidelines

Each section may select a water treatment operator, a water distribution operator, or a wastewater treatment operator or one of each to recognize at its Spring section meeting. The section shall submit the names and contact information for the recipients and their employers to the central office in Jefferson City as soon as possible after the section's Spring meeting.

The central office staff will then obtain biographical information from the recipient and a letter of recommendation from his or her employer. The central office staff will then forward that information to a committee that will choose one individual to be named the state operator of the year. That person will be recognized at Fall annual meeting banquet.

Areas of considerations include but are not limited to: type of plant or system, operational control, maintenance and repair, budget, housekeeping, problem solving, years of service and supervision.
